## MorningTime

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I see your smile. I see your tummy. And I see your feet! (Tickle their feet.) Every time I see feet, I remember how Jesus showed His disciples how to be a good friend by washing their feet. Jesus is the best friend ever!"



## CuddleTime

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for sending Jesus to show us how to be a good friend. Help us put others first like Jesus did when He washed His friends' feet."



## DriveTime

While on the go, talk about what good friends do. A good friend might share with you, spend time with you, or say kind words to you. Talk about how one time, Jesus washed His friends' feet to show them that a good friend puts others first and that they are never too important to serve others.



## Bath Time

Add toys with feet to bath time. Encourage your child to wash their toys' feet while you wash their feet. Talk about how Jesus washed His friends' feet. Jesus washed His friends' feet to show them that a good friend puts other first.
