ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



## Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Today is another happy day! Do you know why today is a happy day? Because Jesus wants to be our friend forever!"



## Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, we are so glad we can talk to You. Thank You for making a way for us to be with You forever. Help us celebrate Jesus every day by loving others the way Jesus loves us."



## Drive Time

While on the go, talk about how your family will celebrate Jesus this year. Will you do things like make a special meal, sing songs, hang decorations, go to church, pray, or make a cake? There are so many ways we can celebrate that Jesus is alive!



## Bath Time

Give your child two washcloths. Tell them to pretend the washcloths are palm branches and Jesus is coming. Encourage your child to wave the washcloths and shout like the people did when they saw Jesus: "Hosanna! Hosanna! Yay, Jesus!"
