



## Unrelenting Grace Grace Is Enough - Week 5

*This resource can be used to guide your personal anchoring time throughout the week, a small group discussion, or even a one-on-one conversation.*

### **READ**

Begin by reading **2 Corinthians 12:6-10**.

- As you read, underline or highlight the promises that you see from God.
- How would you describe transgression and sin to a young child?
- What questions do you have after reading these verses?

### **REFLECT**

*Reread 2 Corinthians 12:6-10.* Paul brings us into his suffering. He describes how he prayed to God in three seasons for relief from the “thorn” in his flesh. God responds with the loving truth that His grace is enough! It will carry our pain and cover our flaws. Despite the pains of this world, God can and will work for joy out of it.

- What are the sins that Paul tells us to avoid or get rid in order to live the fulfilling life God has designed us for?
- How is the power of God made perfect in our weakness in believers?
- Where have you seen the grace of Christ cover pains and flaws in your life?
- *Reread 2 Corinthians 12:10* - What makes it challenging to find joy in weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and difficulties?
- What liberation do you find and feel when you choose joy in Christ in light of weakness?
- Where in your life do you need to delight in Christ despite hardships?
- God’s grace is enough for you. How does the unrelenting grace of Jesus display the power of Christ - despite our weakness?

### **PRAY**

Begin your time of prayer by reading Hebrews 12:1-3. Read it slowly. Now, use this verse to guide your prayer. To get you started...

**FOCUS** on the unrelenting grace of Christ that is present in your weakness.

**THANK** Jesus enduring the cross so that you can experience redemption.

**CONFESS** anything that hinders you and the sin that entangles you.

**ASK** the Spirit to help you set your eyes on Jesus so that you can have the strength to endure and preserve.
