Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



MorningTime

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I'm going to give you a BIG Jesus-size hug because Jesus loves everyone no matter what. That's some really BIG love!"



CuddleTime

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, I know what it feels like to do something wrong. It is not a good feeling. Thank You for sending Jesus to show us that You will always love us no matter what. That is a VERY good feeling!"



DriveTime

While on the go, take turns naming things we can climb. (For example, a ladder, stool, rope, tree, etc.) Talk about how Zacchaeus climbed a tree so he could see Jesus. Jesus was kind and loving to Zaccaheus, because Jesus wanted to be his friend forever.



Bath Time

Play the song "Zacchaeus Was A Wee Little Man" during bath time. Repeat the song and sing along. You can even do the hand motions! Talk about how Jesus loved Zacchaeus even though he had done wrong things because Jesus loves everyone!
