



**Laser Focus**  
**Perspective - Week 3**

*This resource can be used to guide your personal anchoring time throughout the week, a small group discussion, or even a one-on-one conversation.*

**READ**

**Begin by reading 2 Corinthians 4:16–18.**

- As you read, underline or highlight the actions that you see mentioned in the passage.
- How would you define hope? What is something you have hoped for?
- What questions do you have after reading these verses?

**REFLECT**

*Reread 2 Corinthians 4:16–18.* A laser-focused life requires purpose, perseverance, and perspective. Perspective is one's frame of reference in light of various worldviews. There are a multitude of worldviews, but the crux is whether the worldview that you choose focuses your heart and spirit on what you cannot see because it is eternal.

- What contrast do you see in verse 16 between the outward and inward person?
- How does the Holy Spirit renew us inwardly in Christ?
- As you read verse 17, how does the perspective of eternity affect how you perceive the current trials and challenges that you face?
- What changes in your heart and mind when you focus on what is eternal versus what is temporary? How does a laser-focused, eternal perspective give you hope?
- *Read Colossians 3:1–4.* What does it practically look like to set your heart and mind on "things above." How does that worldview play out in how you speak to and treat others?
- What is the difference between placing your confidence in what God says and not what you see in the world around you?
- How does an eternal perspective keep you laser-focused on the purpose of Christ with perseverance? What about your purpose and perseverance should change this week because of this eternal perspective?

**PRAY**

Begin your time of prayer by reading 1 Corinthians 15:55–57. Read it slowly. Now, use this verse to guide your prayer. To get you started...

**FOCUS** on the victory you have in Jesus because of His sacrifice.

**THANK** God for rescuing you from your sin.

**CONFESS** where you have put your confidence in temporary things of this world.

**ASK** God to renew you inwardly and give you a perspective that is laser-focused on the eternal hope you have in Jesus.
