

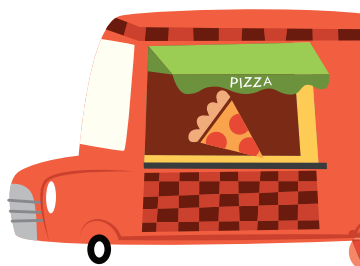

Weekly Parent Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



MorningTime

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Do you know how much Jesus loves children? Jesus loves children so much He told His disciples to let the children come to Him."



CuddleTime

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, I can imagine children running up to see Jesus and Jesus opening His arms and telling everyone to let the children come to Him. Thank You for showing us that children are important and You love them."



DriveTime

While on the go, take turns saying: "Jesus loves [child's name]." When you're done, talk about how Jesus told His disciples to let the children come to Him because Jesus loves all children.



Bath Time

Use bath crayons to practice drawing hearts together. Each time you draw a heart, say: "Jesus loves me!" Then, when you pick your child up to get them out of the tub, say: "One, two, three! Jesus loves ME!"
