## ACTIVITY: BUILD THAT WALL

### WHAT YOU NEED:

Blankets and chairs

### WHAT YOU DO:

During the Activity: Encourage your family to work to build a wall by first arranging the chairs and then covering them with blankets. After the wall is built, gather your family inside the wall and review the Bible story.

### WHAT YOU SAY:

Before the Activity: "Let's build a wall using these blankets and chairs. You can arrange them any way you want. Let's work together, because this is a big job!"

After the Activity: "Wow! What awesome builders you are. Our Bible story today was about a man named Nehemiah. Nehemiah had a big job to do. He wanted to repair the wall that went all the way around the city! It was a very big job. Did he do it all by himself? (Pause.) No way! He had lots of people help him. They marched right up and got to work. Do you think Nehemiah was thankful for the people who helped him? (Pause.) I do, too. God is good to give us people to help us. Who is good? God is good!"

Having people help us is another good gift God gives us. And the Bible verse we're learning will help us remember to thank God because God is good!"
