

Fear Not: Four Truths About Fear, Worry, and Anxiety Week 4 Discussion Questions

GETTING STARTED

What is the funniest quarantine meme you saw this week?

Pray together to open your bible study and discussion time.

In this series, we have seen how misplaced security leads to fear, how doubting fixation results in worry, and how imagined threats lead to anxiety. All of these can ultimately lead us to what is perhaps the greatest underlying fear that humanity faces: the fear of death.

Designate one person to read Hebrews 2:9-18 out loud, as the group follows along.

1. Do you ever wonder, "How am I going to die?" or "What age will I be when I die?" Can you recall specific times in your life when you were afraid to die? What fueled those fears? Do you have a fear of death right now?

Review and discuss the four points made in the message.

Jesus paid the price of death.

Jesus broke the power of death.

Jesus freed us from the fear of death.

Jesus brought death to death through his death.

- 2. Have you ever been tempted to view the grace of God as a pass to sin freely, minimizing the price that Christ paid? Why is it so important to remember the price of death that Jesus paid for us (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)?
- 3. Looking to the apostle Paul as an example (Philippians 1:21-24), what should our attitude as Christ followers be toward *death*? What should our attitude be toward *life*?
- 4. Why would Paul say in 2 Corinthians 5:8 that we should "prefer to be away from the body and home with the Lord?" Why does God call the death of his faithful servants "precious" (Psalm 116:15)?

CLOSING QUESTION

Designate one person to read John 11:25-26 out loud, as the group follows along.

5. Do you believe the words of Jesus? Do you believe that – even in the face of a global pandemic – you do not have to fear death? What gives you confidence to face the inevitability of your own death without fear?

Pray together as a group.

LOOKING AHEAD

In your anchoring time this week...

- Give thanks to God for destroying the power of death over us.
- Pray by name for your friends or family members who do not believe.
- Ask God to give you an opportunity to invite them to join you for Easter online at Hillside.
